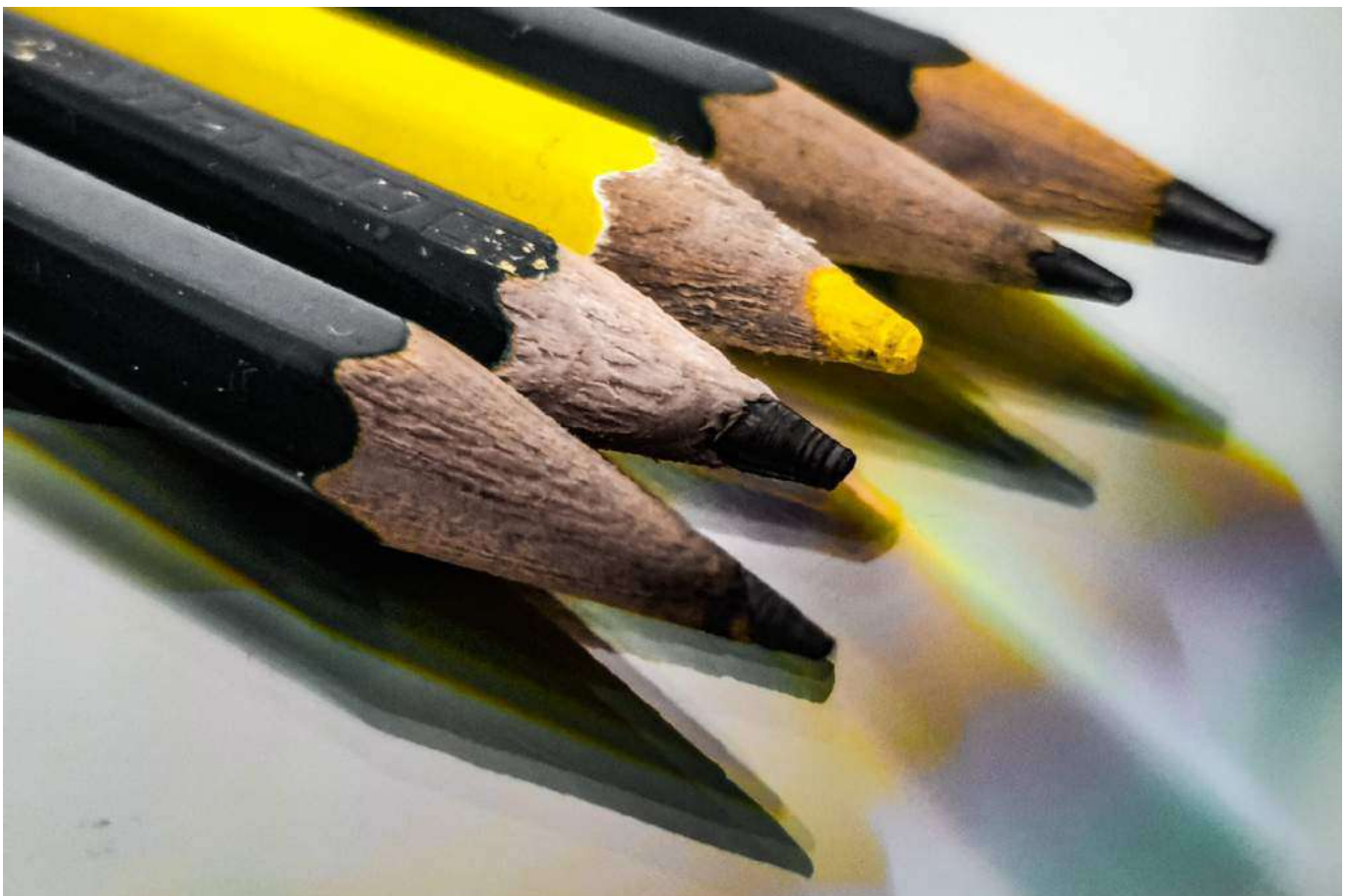

Foreward

Welcome to **ERICA** “Empowering Polytechnic Leaders in Indonesia”, a 2021 – 2022 DIES National Multiplication Training (NMT) program which is funded by DAAD and is coordinated by the Center of Quality Development (ZfQ), University of Postdam.

ERICA is set in the locus of Indonesian higher education landscape, particularly focusing on polytechnics in Indonesia. Data from the Indonesian Ministry of Education and Culture shows that 50% of the existing polytechnics are private polytechnics, and 80% of these private polytechnics are accredited C or even not accredited based-on the national accreditation ranking system. The need to narrow the quality gap across polytechnics, particularly the private ones, is real and pressing. Leaders, particularly those without formal training and experience in higher education management context, are struggling to improve the quality of polytechnics, making the transformation of the institution a long and steep process. **ERICA** is designed to accelerate the capacity building of these leaders which, in turn, can speed up the process of improving the quality of the polytechnics in Indonesia

Twenty five leaders, with different leadership roles in their respective institutions, are selected and committed to participate in **ERICA**. The two-phase program (Phase 1 virtual in December 2021 and Phase Face to Face in May 2022) will discuss issues, challenges, and solutions in higher education through collaborative, integrative, and reflective learning environments. As Confucius says “When I walk along with two others, from at least one I will be able to learn”, it is our hope that the participating leaders can share and learn from each other for the betterment of their institutions.

Leenawaty Limantara is a researcher and a woman leader at a higher education institution in Indonesia. She obtains B.Sc in Biology (1990) from Satya Wacana Christian University, Indonesia; M.Sc in Chemistry (1994), and Ph.D. in Chemistry (1998) from Kwansai Gakuin University, Japan. She pursued postdoctoral study at Department Biologie I, Munich University, Germany in 2001 with Bioscience Special Programme from German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and 2004 with the Georg Forster Fellowship from Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, Germany. She started her career at higher education institution as a faculty member of Faculty of Science and Mathematics, Satya Wacana Christian University (1990 – 2007), Head of Magister Biology Department, Graduate School, Satya Wacana Christian University (2004 – 2007), Indonesia. She was the first rector of Universitas Ma Chung, Malang (2007-2015) and has succeeded to make the university is recognized by the Ministry as one of the top 5 private universities in East Java Province, Indonesia, during her leadership. Then she moved to Universitas Pembangunan Jaya, a private university in Bintaro Jaya as rector for 2015-2023. She has succeeded in transforming Pembangunan Jaya University from a national 1932 ranking in 2015 to a national ranking of 92 according to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology (2020). She is actively involved as an expert, resource person, and trainer in developing research capacity and higher education governance in various national and international activities. She is involved in several national organizations as chairwoman of the Indonesian Pigment Research Association, vice chairwoman of the Association of Indonesian Private Universities (APTISI) Banten Province branch, and vice chairwoman of the community development committee of the Indonesian Rector's Forum (FRI). She is also active as a trainer for the capacity building program for young researchers in ASEAN in the Dialogue on Innovative Higher Education Strategies Proposal Research Grant (DIES ProGRANT) program funded by The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), Germany from 2014-present, involved as a trainer for DIES NMT Indonesia and DIES Partnership Indonesia. Her research works have been recognized by the scientific community in Indonesia and internationally. In the past, she received several prestigious awards, including the 1st Place Lecturer Award (2004) in Central Java Province, 2nd Place National Lecturer Award (2004), Toray Science and Technology Award (2005) from Indonesia Toray Science Foundation, and currently the Humboldt Alumni Award from Humboldt Foundation, Germany (2018).



Eddy Yusuf

Vice Rector for Operational Affairs and Partnerships at Universitas Pembangunan Jaya

Eddy received his Ph.D. in Physics from Florida State University in 2005. His research interest mainly falls in the field of strongly correlated electron systems such as low-dimensional spin systems, quantum dots, and organic superconductors. He also develops interest in the interdisciplinary areas such as biophysics and physics education. Eddy received the Fulbright award to carry out interdisciplinary research in protein dynamics in 2012. At present, Eddy is serving as the Vice Rector for Operational Affairs and Partnership, Universitas Pembangunan Jaya where he oversees the roadmap and strategic plan as well as derives and implements policies in human capital, internationalization, campus operation, income generation units, and centers of excellence. Within Eddy's role in strengthening partnership of the university, he has been leading several international networking initiatives supported by the Humboldt Foundation: 2017 Humboldt Kolleg in Indonesia, 2018 International Workshop, 2019 International Summer School and 2021 International Urban Conference. These networking initiatives carried the umbrella theme of Asian rapid urbanization and its impact on the local, national, and regional levels. In 2020, Eddy was selected to participate in the International Deans Course to broaden his knowledge and sharpen his understanding and skill in higher education management in the international context. Currently, Eddy leads UPJ's team to work on two 3-year grants on institutional capacity building funded by the Humboldt Foundation and the Erasmus+.



Muhammad Ihsan Zul

Assistant Director for Marketing, Cooperation, and Alumni of Politeknik Caltex Riau

Muhammad Ihsan Zul, currently assigned as Assistant Director for Marketing, Cooperation, and Alumni of Politeknik Caltex Riau (PCR). Since 2014, Ihsan has held several structural positions including the head of the Research and Community Service Unit (2014-2016), Head of the Planning and Development (2014-2016), Assistant Director for Academic and Student Affairs (2017), Assistant Director for Finance, Human Resources and General Affairs (2018) and Assistant Director for Marketing, Cooperation and Alumni (2018-2021). In 2018, Ihsan had the opportunity to take part in the Indonesia Deans Course for Private Higher Education (INADC-PHEI) which is a program of DIES NMT in Indonesia. Through these activities, Ihsan was selected as one of the 5 best project implementers. During his tenure as Assistant Director for Marketing, Cooperation, and Alumni, Ihsan managed to bring various changes in the fields under his management. Some of the achievements include the best poster for the national tracer study seminar in Bali and the Best Career Center in 2019 by the Directorate General of Learning and Students Affairs, Ministry of Research, Technology, and Higher Education. He is also actively involved in the preparation of various national and international competitive grants won by PCR. The grant can accelerate PCR to continue to innovate and develop in line with the institution's vision and mission. In addition, Ihsan was also assigned to manage a business unit under the coordination of PCR, which is one of the income generators of Politeknik Caltex Riau.

Expert Profile



Tatas Brotosudarmo

Director, Ma Chung Research Center for Photosynthetic Pigments (MRCPP), Ma Chung University

Raden Mas (RM) Tatas Hardo Panintingjati Brotosudarmo, born in the city of Pati in 1981, is a scientist in the field of photosynthesis in Indonesia. He is best known for discovering the crystal structure of the light-catching protein LH2 from the bacterium *Rhodospseudomonas palustris* and analyzing its function by single-molecule spectroscopy and femtoseconds. However, in 2011, he pioneered research on photosynthetic pigments, taking the theme of Indonesia's biodiversity, and linking it to functional food and agriculture. It is the research work in the natural pigment field that has influenced the government's policy on the use of synthetic food coloring, to shift to more environmentally friendly solutions. For this contribution, the British Council awarded him the Professional Achievement Award, The UK Alumni Award 2017. Dr. Brotosudarmo is an alumnus of the Satya Wacana Christian University (S1 Chemistry, 2001), Ludwig Maximilians University Munich (S2 Chemical Physics, 2006), and the University of Glasgow (S3 Molecular and Cell Biology, 2010). His professional academic achievements include establishing the Ma Chung Research Center for Photosynthetic Pigments (MRCPP) at Ma Chung University, Malang and successfully leading the institution, which was designated by the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education in 2015 as the Center for Excellence in Higher Education Science and Technology (PUI-PT). This success led him to become a National Expert of DIES (Dialogue on Innovative Higher Education Strategies), a training program coordinated by the German DAAD and the German Chancellors' Conference (HRK) to increase the capacity of the leadership of higher education institutions in ASEAN.



Peter Mayer

Professor - Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences

Peter Mayer is Professor of International Economics at the University of Applied Science Osnabrück. He holds a doctorate from the Goethe University, Frankfurt. Between 2003 and 2007, Professor Mayer was Dean of the Faculty for Business Management and Social Sciences of the University of Applied Science Osnabrück as well as Vice President for International Affairs. In his teaching, he focusses on international economic relations, European integration, and business ethics. Short term teaching assignments brought him to Oshkosh/USA, Port Elizabeth/South Africa, Vilnius /Lithuania, Bratislava/Slovakia, Seoul/ South Korea and Paris/France. From 2006 to 2012, he was a member of the accreditation committee for private higher education institutions of the German Council of Science and Humanities and concurrently referee for some DAAD programmes. He was also referee for research projects of Universities of Applied Sciences in North Rhine Westphalia (2006-2007) and in Baden-Württemberg (2007- 2016). His research and publications concentrate on European integration and higher education issues. For the DIES programme, he has been project manager for the International Deans' Course since 2007.

Prof. Dr. Maria Flordeliza L. Anastacio

Vice President for CEU Malolos and Dean of Studies

Prof. Dr. Maria Flordeliza L. Anastacio is the Vice President and Dean of Studies of Centro Escolar University, Malolos City, Philippines. She is a University Professor, a Certified Public Accountant, a quality advocate, a human resource consultant, an author, a researcher, and an international lecturer. She was the 5th National President of the Philippine Council of Deans and Educators in Business (PCDEB), the 5th National President of the Philippine Society for Educational Research and Evaluation (PSERE) and the co-founder and now President of the International Academy of Accountants for Business Research and Education (IAABRE). In 2008, she went to Germany as one of the first four Filipino Scholars of the International Deans' Course (IDC) a scholarship program of the DAAD-DIES. Today, she is one of the IDC Regional Experts/Mentors of South East Asia.



Prof. Dr. Frank Ziegele

Executive Director of CHE Centre of Higher Education

Frank Ziegele is executive director of the CHE Centre for Higher Education, Gütersloh, a German think tank for higher education policy and management. He is also professor for higher education and research management at the University of Applied Sciences Osnabrück. He was trained as economist and his focus lies on higher education finance, governance, policies, strategic management, contract management, ranking and accounting. In these areas he also acts as consultant, trainer and speaker all over the world. He has contributed with more than 150 publications to the field of higher education policy and management and has realised around 100 national and international projects, for instance as co-leader of the European U-Multirank project. He is or was member in several boards, such as the editorial board of the journals "Wissenschaftsmanagement" and "Application-Oriented Higher Education Research" or the executive board of the German Society for Higher Education Research. At UAS Osnabrück he leads the national MBA Programme for Higher Education Management and the international Erasmus Mundus Master Programme for Research and Innovation in Higher Education. Frank Ziegele works in the context of African higher education since 10 years, for instance as expert and/or designer of the International Deans' Course, the UNILEAD course and the GIZ leadership training for Ethiopian university leaders. He worked in Kenya, Ethiopia, Ghana, Sudan, Nigeria, Namibia, South Africa and Uganda.



Dr. Gladys Nivera

Professor and Former Associate Dean

Dr. Gladys Nivera is a faculty in mathematics education with a Professor 6 rank. She served as Associate Dean of the Faculty of Science, Technology and Mathematics (2013 – 2020) and Mathematics Department Chair (2011 – 2013). As a two-term presidential appointee and Mathematics Teachers' Representative in the Teacher Education Council (TEC) (2007 – 2014), she engaged in policy-making at the national level and helped implement select Commission on Higher Education and Department of Education programs. She obtained her Ph.D. in Science Education Major in Mathematics from the De la Salle University and B.S. for Mathematics Teachers degree from PNU, both as DOST scholar. She was a mathematics education PROBE fellow at the Queensland University of Technology in Australia. Her research interests include mathematical investigations and STEM education. On the side, she writes mathematics textbooks for K to 10. She is an alumna of IDC Southeast Asia 2016/2017 and the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) Flagship Course on Academic Excellence for State Universities and Colleges. 2014 – 2015. Currently she is a facilitator in IDC-SEA and a resource person in a DIES management and leadership for Christian higher education institutions in Indonesia (2020 – 2023). Also, she is the Vice President of the Philippine Council of Mathematics Teacher Educators (MATHTED), Inc. (2020 – 2022)



Dr. Jutta Fedrowitz

Senior Expert, Professional Education and Trainings, CHE Centre for Higher Education

Dr. Jutta Fedrowitz is heading CHE's area of continuing education in HE-Management. She specializes in professional training for higher education leaders, deans and faculty managers. She also directs CHE's HE management programmes and workshops and works as a certified professional education trainer since 2010. Since 2016 she is project leader and trainer of GIZ leadership trainings for Ethiopian university deans and presidents). Since 2015, she heads a workshop series for university presidents and directors of administration and finance; since 2012, she is responsible for CHE's university vice presidents' leadership programme. For CHE, she has been project leader for the "International Deans' Course" since 2006. Before joining CHE, Dr. Fedrowitz worked as a programme manager at the Centre for Arts and Sciences, state chancellery of North Rhine-Westphalia in Düsseldorf, Germany. She was managing a working group on biosensorics and interdisciplinary conferences on culture and technology in the 21st century. After earning her doctorate in biochemistry (enzymology) in 1986, she headed a biochemical research lab in food industry. Dr. Fedrowitz studied biology and chemistry (completing Germany's state examinations for teachers) from 1976 to 1982.

Dr. Beny Bandanadjaja was born in Jakarta on September 30 1970. He received his bachelor degree in Mechanical Engineering from Institut Teknologi Bandung in 2002 and completed his Master degree in the same field and institution in 2004. He then pursued his doctorate degree in Material Science and Engineering from Institut Teknologi Bandung and secure his doctorate in 2009. Dr. Benny Bandanadjaja started his career as an engineer at PT Hanco Foundry Industry from 1993 – 1994. He then focuses his career path in education, starting as an instructor in engine molding at POLMAN Bandung from 1995 – 1997, Coordinator of Research and Community Service and Head of Material Laboratory at POLMAN Bandung from 2013 – 2017 and Vice Director of Academics from 2017 – 2020 in the same institution. Since 2020, Dr. Benny Bandanadjaja was appointed as the Director of Vocational and Professional Higher Education, Directorate General of Vocational Education, Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology.

Dr. Hendriko, S.T., M.Eng. has been a lecturer at Politeknik Caltex Riau since 2001. He obtained a bachelor's degree from the Department of Mechanical Engineering, University of North Sumatra, in 2000. Then, he received a master's degree from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia in 2008. He continued his doctoral education through the Double Degree Indonesia Perancis Program (DDIP). His doctoral studies were successfully completed in 2014. He received doctorate degrees from two prominent universities, Universitas Indonesia and Unviersite Clermont in France. As a lecturer, he has taught several subjects, such as manufacturing processes, mechanical technology, engineering kinematics, strength of material, and research methodologies. Besides teaching, Dr. Hendriko is also experienced in carrying out management functions at the Politeknik Caltex Riau. He was appointed as Deputy Director for Cooperation and Business Development, Deputy Director of Finance and Resources, and Director in 2014-2018. Dr. Hendriko is widely involved as a trainer in various training programs carried out by LLDIKTI X. Some of the training programs that have been delivered include drafting statutes, preparing accreditation documents, quality assurance, and drafting articles for drafting international journals. Dr. Hendriko is also frequently invited by private universities to assist in developing higher education governance. Since 2018 Dr. Hendriko has also been appointed by BAN-PT as assessor for accreditation of study programs. In 2021, he was successfully elected as a member of the BAN-PT Accreditation Council.
